

Spread out in large area creating a number of smaller spots for tent set up. Osprey shelter borders this tent site; book shelter to use. Not available if any of the sub-sites have been rented.

Closer to the lake, no parking, plan time to carry your gear down to site. Not available if any of the sub-sites have been rented.
